

Staff – Ministry Descriptions

Counselors:

Provide daily primary care for campers. Counselors are the front lines of our ministry – caring for the physical, emotional, and spiritual needs of the campers as they experience camp together.

Co-Counselors:

Assist Counselors in the primary care of campers, without the full care responsibilities.

Program Assistants:

Serve alongside the Program Manager to oversee program activities, camper care, and counselor success.

Program Staff:

Serve alongside the Program Manager with responsibilities focused in specific program areas. Program Staff also assist Counselors and Co-Counselors in the primary care of campers.

Nurse's Assistant:

Serves directly under the Head Nurse to provide assistance in the areas of medication distribution, camper health, and first aid treatment.

Media Design Coordinator:

Works with the Camp Director and Program Manager and is responsible for daily photography, yearbook and photobook creation, website updates, social media communication, and graphic design for program needs.

Nightwatch:

Serves overnight as awake staff to ensure camper safety, perform hourly checks, and assist Counselors as needed.

Lifeguard:

Provides authority, safety, and oversight of waterfront activities – swimming, boating, program activities, etc.

Assistant Cook:

Serve alongside the Head Cook(s) to prepare, serve, and clean up camp meals and snacks.

James Project Coordinator:

Works with the Camp Director and Head Cook(s) to train, mobilize, and manage James Project volunteer groups.

Maintenance Assistant:

Serves alongside the Operations Manager to complete projects and tasks related to facilities, grounds, and equipment maintenance.

Staff Disciplers:

Serves alongside the full time staff to facilitate, lead, and support all seasonal staff through discipleship, mentoring, and practical service.
